A large number of people attended the Remembrance Service which raised £333 for the Royal British Legion. Keith Banks sounded Last Post and Reveille, the readings were poignant and beautifully read and Dick gave a thoughtful talk. It was all well received.

#### Tower antenna.

We had a major disappointment in September when Net Solutions pulled out of the project for O2 and Vodafone. This was mainly due to delays by the DAC and B&NES in processing the application which meant the two 'phone companies would miss their targets for completion. The hoped for improvements for mobiles within the village, and the major boost to PCC funds will not now materialise.

#### Church toilet and kitchenette.

On 26<sup>th</sup> October members of the DAC plus representatives from Historic England and B&NES and our architect visited to hear our plans for achieving these improvements. The options were outlined and our reasons for unanimously proposing the Tower option were explained.

Following discussion it was agreed the Tower option would best meet our requirements but made clear that the idea of an entry point through the tower could be a stumbling block.

It has been decided to pursue this option.
